

#### Camellia Day in Alabama



Camellia Day is celebrated annually on January 7th in Alabama, marking the beginning of the peak blooming season for the camellia, the state's official flower. The Alabama Legislature proclaimed this day in 2014 to honor the camellia's significance in the state's cultural and horticultural heritage.

The camellia, originally native to Asia, has become deeply rooted in Alabama's history since its introduction in the 1800s. Its vibrant winter blooms have made it a cherished symbol across the state. In 1959, the camellia was designated as Alabama's state flower, replacing the goldenrod.

Communities throughout Alabama observe Camellia Day with various events and activities, including educational programs, garden tours, and camellia shows. These celebrations offer residents and visitors the opportunity to appreciate the beauty of camellias and learn about their cultivation.
